QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School diploma/GED with 1 year of working experience required. Associate's degree, training as a Peer Specialist or experience as an Outreach Worker preferred.
- Experience working with chronic diseases including heart disease, substance use, HIV/AIDS, diabetes, etc.
- Knowledge of medical and mental health services, benefits and entitlements, and housing in county is helpful.
- Proven customer service and sales skills are **highly desired**.
- Must have a familiarity with assigned neighborhoods and willingness to travel throughout the area.
- Must be proficient in computer applications or other automated systems such as spreadsheets, Microsoft Office applications, calendar, and email and/or database software necessary to preform work assignments.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct computer, phone, mail and in-person outreach to locate and engage consumers who meet the qualifications of the program. Requires a significant amount of time out in the field. Home visits and cold calls required.
- Complete all required trainings on the designated assessment tool, health coaching and other applicable topics.
- Complete consumer surveys, meeting monthly and annual targets.
- Refer clients to appropriate medical and community resources.
- Work with Program Director to identify and engage community partners and medical providers.
- Complete all required reporting of contact with clients in a timely manner utilizing computer record systems.
- Participate in team meetings and report any issues affecting compliance, engagement and enrolment.
- Maintain client confidentiality.
