EAC NETWORK seeks a bilingual Social Worker to be responsible for providing support group services to Spanish speaking youth who have been trafficked or are at risk of being trafficked or are victims of Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children. Position is for up to 5 hours weekly (flexible schedule-possible evenings or weekends). All qualified applicants will be afforded equal opportunities without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, marital status, sex, age, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, or protected veteran status. RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Using an evidence based curricula the bilingual social worker will facilitate bilingual group services support to youth who have been trafficked or are at risk of being trafficked.
- Provide data tracking of meetings conducted by staff facilitators.
- Identify participants with emergent needs in order to refer to Safe Harbour Coordinator.
- Complete monthly written reports, statistics and progress notes in a timely manner regarding clients' progress.
- Participate in team meetings and case conferences.
- Patriciate in human trafficking, commercial sexual exploitation and trauma trainings.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master degree in Social Worker required.
- Fluent in Spanish / English.
- Working knowledge human trafficking, commercial sexual exploitation of children, child abuse and trauma.
- Must be proficient in computer applications or other automated systems such as spreadsheets,
 Microsoft Office applications, calendar, and email and/or database software necessary to perform work assignments.
- Utilize the educational training, skills and experience obtained from advanced degree to provide appropriate professional services, techniques and strategies for clients.
- Must have good communication skills, both oral and written in English and Spanish.
