<i>What year interns do you accept for placement?</i>	Juniors, Seniors and Masters level students majoring in social work, forensic psychology, or a behavioral science. Two-day minimum commitment required. Spanish speaking a plus	Students majoring in psychology, social work, vocational counseling, vocational psychology or any behavioral science	Undergraduate Junior or Senior and Graduate level students specific to Forensic Mental Health/Mental Health Counseling
<i>Hours/days internships are available</i>	Flexible hours and days (Office Hours Tuesday Thursday and Friday 9-5 Monday and Wednesday 9:00AM-6:30PM)	Flexible hours and days (Office Hours 8-5 Monday – Friday)	preferably 1-3 days per week. Intern is free to suggest their own recurring schedule between the hours of 9:00AM-5:00PM.
<i>Population served</i>	Individuals with severe mental illness who are reentering New York City from Rikers Island, Additionally, in Brooklyn, Staten Island and Manhattan, mentally ill and chemically addicted clients with open Supreme or Criminal court cases. Age 16 years or older, living in any of the 5 boroughs.	TANF eligible TASC clients who are in need of educational and vocational services.	The Offender Reentry Program (ORP) is a voluntary program designed to assist offenders with co-occurring substance use and mental disorders (COD) consistent with the DSM-IV, aged 18 and older, returning to New York City (NYC) from New York State (NYS) Department of Correction and Community Supervision (DOCCS) prisons after serving a minimum sentence of 6 months for a felony.
