

# How can Health Home help you?

## Who can join a Health Home?

Anyone who is eligible for Medicaid and has two chronic conditions such as diabetes, asthma, heart disease, high blood pressure, substance use, obesity, HIV/AIDS, or a mental health diagnosis may be able to join.



## How are participants referred?

## Is there a fee for services?

Health Home Care Coordination is a free service funded by Medicaid. Health Home is a completely voluntary program.

## What is a Health Home?

A health home is not a physical space. It is a group of health and community agencies that have agreed to work together to help Medicaid members with serious and chronic health issues get additional support services and stay healthy & safe within their communities.

## What can my care coordinator help me with?

- Making appointments
- Communicating between your doctors and other providers
- Answering questions about your health care
- Provide linkage to: medications, food, treatment for your health conditions
- Applying for benefits such as SSI/SSD, SNAP, Public Assistance, medical transportation, housing

## What is Health Home Plus?

Health Home Plus is an enhanced level of care coordination within the Health Home program that services individuals with a Serious Mental Illness (SMI) and a secondary qualifying factor such as:

- Homelessness
- Release from incarceration within the last year
- High utilization of psychiatric inpatient or ED visits



## Health Home Collaboration

EAC Network is a care management agency contracted to provide Health Home care coordination under Sun River and the New York State Department of Health.
