SAFE HARBOUR

Named after the NY Safe Harbour Act of 2008, Safe Harbour protects and cares for children that have been, or are at risk of being victims of commercial sex trafficking.

The act issued a system level approach, calling for existing systems to provide efficient responses to youth who have experienced commercial sexual exploitation or are vulnerable to it.

At Safe Harbour we offer an array of services to our survivors and at-risk youth to help them get back on their feet. We assist youth with case management, referrals (including shelters, residential placement, therapy, and more), group counseling and support, education and vocational advocacy (including help with resume building, job readiness, and job placement) potential police intervention and community education.

WHY MENTORING MATTERS

Mentoring is an opportunity to show young people that there is someone who cares about them. Through mentoring youth can feel like they are not alone in dealing with their day-to-day challenges and be built up in their confidence, selfesteem, and self-worth. Research has confirmed that consistent and committed mentoring relationships have powerful positive effects on youth in all areas of their life including improved academic, social and economic prospects.

Mentoring provides meaningful connections that positively impact all involved and can transform communities. For those who are mentoring, this relationship can also build leadership skills, expand a mentor's network, and provide an inspiring opportunity to give back to the community.

Ongoing training and supervision is provided.
